PROJECT MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATE

Explore the critical skills every project manager needs to be successful. Aligned with the Project Management Institute's Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®).



Course Description

Achieving success in project goals and inspiring a sense of shared purpose within the project team requires project managers to be change agents for their organization.

This course is aligned with national certification and teaches the skills needed to find project management success in their workplace whether they continue on to the certifying exam or not.

Students will learn about the human side of project management, approaches for Agile, iterative, and adaptive environments, and prepare for the PMP® or CAPM® Exam.

Audience

This course is designed for individuals with varying backgrounds and experiences. Anyone relatively new to project management or those who are currently working on projects will be well positioned to excel in this program.

Each pathway will provide the skills and current industry best practices needed for current project management professionals who seek to remain current in their field.

Earn the 35 educational hours needed to sit for PMI certification upon successful completion.

Course Information

Two pathways to the same certificate. Both programs are designed with the equivalent learning outcomes.

PMC 100

5 weeks of virtual instructor led lectures via Zoom. Check our schedule.

PMC 500

5 weeks of self-paced learning. Begin the Sunday following enrollment.

Plan to spend about 7 hours per week on coursework.

Overview & Assignments

PMC 100—Instructor Led

Class will meet for 3 hours weekly for 5 weeks over Zoom led by a live instructor. Additional readings and assignments completed on your schedule.

PMC 500—Self-Paced

Work through 5 weeks of guided learning comprised of multimedia interactive modules and curated readings. Discussion posts due on Mondays and all other deliverables due on Saturdays.

Outcomes

The course will equip you to:

- Analyze the role of project management in contemporary organizations
- Evaluate the various project management models, including an overview of the Agile model
- Utilize critical project management terminology used throughout the PMBOK® and PMP® exams
- Describe the key components of the five phases of every project: initiation, planning, execution, monitoring & controlling, and closure
